Remember to add \$30.00 if you want to add a stop for lunch. This is to cover the additional hour of the service of the tour guide. The \$30.00 is a one-time charge that can be spread out among everyone in the party. For example, if 5 people want a walking tour including a stop for them to buy lunch at a café or restaurant, each person can pay \$6.00 or 1/5 of the amount of \$30.00. The \$30.00 **IS NOT COVERING FREE MEALS**.

Important Note to Teachers and Schools: We repeatedly have had schoolteachers, overstate or inflate their numbers to pay lower prices and then object to paying the balance owed. For example, they will state in advance that they will have 30 students at \$10.00 per student when they only have 27 students at \$15.00 per student on the day of the tour. Since the prices of tours are published, the teachers know exactly what they are doing. The teachers reneging on paying the balance have created unethical as well as legal conflicts with students present that should not exist. This has happened with both public and parochial schools. This is very disappointing. As a result, all balances **MUST** be paid in full in **CASH**, just like all other parties, at the outset of the tour before we begin. If the leader or teacher refuses or does not pay the balance in full in cash at the outset of a tour, the tour will be shortened by **AT LEAST** 30 minutes or more. This will certainly eliminate going into an observation deck and buildings. If necessary, we will also refer the school to a collection agency.
